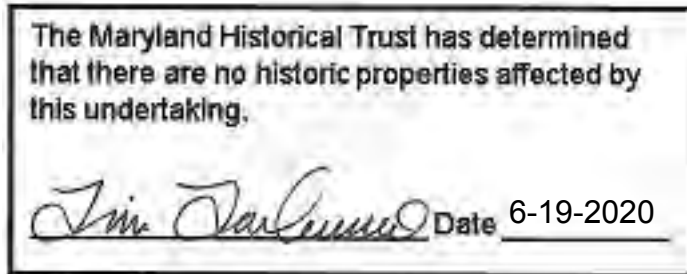

Subject: Request for Project Review and Comment

Dear Ms. Hughes:

RK&K is providing engineering and environmental services to the City of Takoma Park for the New Ave Bikeway – Section B project in Montgomery County, Maryland. The project area is located along the southbound side of MD 650 (New Hampshire Avenue) from Poplar Avenue to Auburn Avenue (Attachment A and B).

The project is partly funded by a Maryland Department of Transportation Bikeways Program grant. A review of the MEDUSA Online system indicated that there are no archaeological sites and no previous archaeological surveys within the project area. The project area contains one MIHP property (PG-65-16-32), the Washington-McLaughlin Christian School which was evaluated as not eligible for the NRHP in 1996. Several historic properties are located within a quarter-mile radius of the project area, but no archaeological sites have been recorded.
